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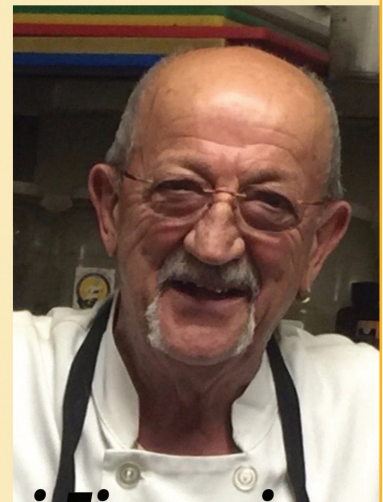

MESSAGE FROM CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER

Last issue, we promised a completion report regarding the weight room and locker room. The feedback has been overwhelmingly positive from longtime and new members alike. The weight-room footprint was expanded and enhanced with a new rubber flooring. The rubber protects the underlying floor from the weights while providing comfort to users during their workouts. A fresh coat of paint and new LED lighting freshened the space. Some underutilized and damaged equipment was removed-freeing up space for new equipment. Contact member Andrew Humaydan who is fundraising for a new squat rack and other pieces of equipment if you are feeling generous.

The locker room was completely remodeled with new rough plumbing, fixtures, flooring, wall-mounted lockers and a custom bench. Three new shower doors were installed in the existing facilities and the steam room has never been hotter! The exhaust fan was replaced on the roof, greatly improving air circulation. There is chilled Alhambra water available and towel service, so come use the Club for a workout, steam, and shower. A big thank you to John our plumber, Giovanni our carpenter, and Al Cipollina (from the Building Association) for their contributions to this project.

Submissions for Bylaws changes ***must be received by the bylaws chair by Monday, October 21, 2019.*** Bylaws proposals must be submitted in writing by this date. Any proposals received after this date will not be accepted for this year's consideration.

In effect, all Bylaws must be presented in the order described on the Bylaws' Revision Form. Updated Club bylaws and additional change forms are available for viewing and are downloadable on the SFIAC website: www.sfiac.org. Copies can also be picked up at the Club bar and/or office.

Submit your change proposals - typed, or printed in English and typo-free to Marc Libarle, Bylaws chair, at administration@sfiac.org. Please include SFIAC Bylaw in your e-mail subject line. You may also drop off change proposals in person at the Club

The following is the procedure that must be followed for each bylaw submission:

Name of member citing the bylaw.

Original bylaw must be cited by the Article and Section; it must then be typed or printed as stated in the bylaws.

Change must be typed or printed in English.

Reason for change must be given.

Members will be given a copy of all changes submitted during the meeting.

Change(s) will be presented by originator before the membership at the bylaws' meeting.

Members will vote yes or no or abstain for each change submitted.

Order of presentation will be based on first received.
